This scholarship will consist of:

A scholarship for the amount of \$10,000 per year, for a period of up to 4 years, while you undertake full-time university study in civil and/or structural engineering; and
Offer of a paid internship to develop your experience in engineering (to be negotiated around your university study and vacation periods). Paid at award wage for up to 40 hours per week, for up to 12 weeks per year.

To be successful in this application:

Students must identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Australian Citizens;
The applicant will live in the Shoalhaven or Illawarra region;
Demonstrate academic achievement in their high school studies; and
Show a commitment to an engineering career.

Your academic responsibilities will include:

Applicants must be currently studying in year 12, with the intention enrolling full-time in a Bachelor of Engineering (Civil / Structural) in 2021; or
Applicants must be enrolled full-time in a Bachelor of Engineering (Civil / Structural);
Applicants must remain enrolled with a full-time course load each semester to be eligible for that semester's payment; and
Applicants must maintain a credit average or above for the duration of their scholarship.

To apply, please provide:

A brief cover letter addressing the above criteria;
A brief resume outlining your experience, study and extra-curricular activities to date;
A copy of your most recent high school achievements and grades (i.e. transcripts); and
A one-page outline of how this scholarship will assist you in your career ambitions.
